Gily Coene (PhD in Ethics and Moral Sciences, Ghent University, 2004) is Associate Professor at the Dept. of History, Archeology, Arts & Philosophy & the Dept. of Political Sciences and Director of the RHEA, Research Centre on Gender, Diversity and Intersectionality at the Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB). She teaches feminist thought, genderstudies, humanist philosophy, empirical and applied ethics and philosophy of sexuality. Her research mainly concerns issues of gender equality and moral diversity. She has over 100 publications in journals and books and is engaged in multiple cross-disciplinary research projects on migration, diversity and citizenship, sexual and reproductive rights, gender-based violence and empirical bio-ethics in European and non-European countries.
